OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed December 1, 1986, Teleconnect, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, seeks to revise its tariff to provide for SUPERWATS and MEGANET service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff for interLATA service to offer SUPERWATS and MEGANET services. SUPERWATS is a WATS-like service offering. MEGANET is accessed by means other than the switched telephone network and is intended for large volume areas.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-701 be and it is hereby granted and Teleconnect be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
