OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed December 4, 1986, the K & M Telephone Company, Inc., Chambers, Nebraska, seeks approval of tariffs for radio telephone and paging service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Section 7, Original Sheets 1-8

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer two-way mobile and one-way paging service at Chambers, Nebraska. Rates proposed are \$30.00 per month for Radio Telephone Access, \$5.50 per month for Radio Paging Access, and \$10.00 per month for each Multiple Station.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-702 be and it is hereby granted and the K & M Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
