By its application filed December 19, 1986, the Omaha Cellular Limited Partnership, Centel Cellular Company, General Partner, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its tariff.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to allow customers who agree to a 12-month minimum service period to subscribe to Flat Rate Multiple Number Service.
