OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered February 3, 1987 in Application No. C-540, the Commission reduced rates of Northwestern Bell Telephone Company for customer provided coin telephone service to the level of business rates.

The only other telephone companies whose rates for such service are higher than the business rate are General Telephone Company of the Midwest (C-571), The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company (C-572), and United Telephone Company of the West (C-597).

These telephone companies should be ordered to show cause, if any there be, why rates and charges for customer provided coin telephone service should not be set at the business one party rate or business measured service rate where measured service is offered. Public hearing on this matter should be held on March 18, 1987 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that General Telephone Company of the Midwest, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, and United Telephone Company of the West be and they are hereby ordered to appear at a public hearing to be held on March 18, 1987 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska, and show cause, if any there be, why rates and charges for customer provided coin telephone service should not be set at the business one party rate or business measured service rate where measured service is offered.
