## OPINION AND FINDINGS

## BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered February 3, 1987, General Telephone Company of the Midwest, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, and United Telephone Company of the West were ordered to show cause, if any there be, why rates and charges for customer provided coin telephone service should not be set at the business 1-party rate or business measured service rate where measured service is offered.

Applications were filed by General Telephone Company of the Midwest on February 23, 1987; by United Telephone Company of the West on February 24, 1987; and by The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company on March 6, 1987 to designate the business 1-party rate for customer provided coin telephone service.

Upon consideration of the order to show cause and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the order to show cause should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the order to show cause in Docket No. C-713 be and it is hereby dismissed.
