OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed February 18, 1987, Great Plains Communications, Blair, Nebraska, seeks authority to eliminate party line service at Arnold, Stapleton, and Wausa.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to eliminate party line service at Arnold, Stapleton, and Wausa, Nebraska, as a part of its plant modernization and service improvement program. All one party service will be provided at these exchanges in 1987 and party line service and mileage charges will be eliminated.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-716 be and it is hereby granted and Great Plains Communications be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff as set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission within 30 days from the date of this order.
