OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed February 24, 1987, United Telephone Company of the West, Topeka, Kansas, seeks authority to designate the B-1 rate or measured rate for access line of customer owned semi-public coin telephone service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to provide that the Business 1 party flat rate or measured rate applies for access line of customer owned semi-public coin telephone service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-722 be and it is hereby granted and United Telephone Company of the West be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission within 30 days from the date of this order.
