OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed March 6, 1987, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its tariff to designate B-1 rate for access line of customer-provided semi-public coin telephone service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Local Exchange Tariff, Ninth Revised Sheet 12
Local Exchange Tariff, Ninth Revised Sheet 13
General Exchange Tariff, Section 14, First Revised Sheet 4

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to provide that the business 1 party rate applies for access lines of customer-owned semi-public coin telephone service and that measured rates will apply when measured service is offered.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-724 be and it is hereby granted and The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission within 30 days from the date of this order.
