OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION

On February 14, 1989, on its own motion, the Commission opened an investigation into procedures followed by telecommunications companies when a customer changes its interexchange carrier. Notice was published and a hearing was held pursuant thereto on April 5, 1989.

In December, 1991, the Federal Communications Commission, in Docket C-91-64, established rules for changing long distance carriers thereby eliminating the necessity for the Commission to adopt such rules. Therefore, the proceedings in C-768 should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-768 be and is hereby dismissed.
