OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 30, 1989, the Telephone Committee and Citizens for EAS et. al. of Ashland, Nebraska requested extended area service for the community of Ashland, Nebraska to the Omaha calling area.

Pursuant to law notice of this application was published in the Daily Record on November 3, 1989, in Omaha, Nebraska.

On December 1, 1989, a protest was received from the Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company. On December 4, 1989, a intervention was filed with comments by AT&T. On December 4, 1989, a formal intervention in the above described proceeding was filed by Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a US West Communications.

On February 20, 1990, the Applicant, by letter, advised this Commission of their request to withdraw the application for extended area service to Omaha.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-788 be and it is hereby dismissed.
