OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 20, 1989, the Hartington Telephone Company, Hartington, Nebraska seeks approval of Basis Date Agreements.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application has been filed.

By its order entered December 6, 1983, in Application No. C-442, the Commission authorized applicant herein to borrow up to \$746,000 from the Rural Electrification Administration and up to \$1,279,950 from the Rural Telephone Bank.

Of the original loan, the sum of \$1,231,950 was not drawn and remains unadvanced. Applicant seeks approval of Basis Date Agreements to be entered into between it and the Rural Electrification Administration and Rural Telephone Bank extending the period during which said unadvanced loan funds may be drawn for three years from December 21, 1989. Copies of said Basis Date Agreements are attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant plans to use the unadvanced funds for the upgrading of service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-791 be and it is hereby granted and the Hartington Telephone Company, Hartington, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to enter into Basis Date Agreements with the Rural Electrification Administration and Rural Telephone Bank as set forth in the Opinion and Finds.
