OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered June 7, 1988 in Docket C-747, this Commission adopted a Link-Up Nebraska Plan in accordance with FCC guidelines.

On January 18, 1990, notice was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, of the Commission's consideration of modifying the provisions of Docket C-747. No comments or protests were filed.

Upon consideration of this matter, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the following modifications to the Link-Up Nebraska Plan would eliminate two limitations on the eligibility of potential beneficiaries.

- 1. That an applicant must have lived at an address where there has been no telephone service for at least three months prior to the date assistance is requested.
- 2. That the applicant must not have received this assistance within the last two years.

The FCC has adopted the foregoing modifications to its Link-Up America Plan.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Link-Up Nebraska Plan be modified to eliminate the criteria set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that appropriate tariffs or price lists be filed with the Commission within 30 days reflecting the modifications ordered herein.
