BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 19, 1990, AT&T of the Midwest, Omaha, Nebraska seeks authority to revise depreciation rates for classes of its Nebraska telecommunications equipment investment.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protests or petitions to intervene were filed, and thus, this application may be processed administratively pursuant to the Commission's Rules. Upon consideration of the application, and the information presented to the Commission staff by applicant, and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

1. Applicant is a common carrier furnishing interexchange services for hire in Nebraska under the jurisdiction of this Commission.
2. This application is submitted in accordance with this Commission's order entered in Application No. C-664 on April 14, 1987, which allows for rate review concurrent with FCC review.
3. Based upon the information which applicant has presented to the Commission and the independent analysis thereof which has been performed by the staff, the Commission finds that the depreciation rates set forth in the column entitled "Remaining Life Rate" of Exhibit 1 attached hereto are fair and reasonable, are supported by the evidence and should be approved.
4. The application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interests and should be granted as set forth above.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-808 is hereby granted and AT&T of the Midwest is authorized to revise its depreciation rates for its Nebraska intrastate investment effective January 1, 1989.
