OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By docket opened August 7, 1990, the Commission on its own motion seeks to determine the boundary between the Kenesaw exchange of the Lincoln Telephone Company and the Shelton exchange of the Nebraska Central Telephone Company.

Both the Lincoln Telephone Company and the Nebraska Central Telephone Company were notified of this docket and directed to propose a revised boundary which will eliminate the duplicate service area.

Both telephone companies have agreed that the area in question should be included in the Shelton exchange of the Nebraska Central Telephone Company and one customer, Virgil Ramsey, should be allowed to continue to receive telephone service from the Kenesaw exchange. If the customer moves or sells the property or business or the existing service is disconnected for any other reason then new service must be provided solely by the Nebraska Central Telephone Company, the only exception being that service may be transferred to another family member who is a member of the household at that time.

Virgil Ramsey was notified of this proposal by certified mail on February 25, 1992 and given 30 days in which to request a public hearing. No response has been received.

Upon consideration of the docket and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that a boundary has been agreed upon by all parties which will eliminate the duplicate service area in question between the Kenesaw and Shelton exchanges. Both telephone companies should be ordered to file revised service area maps showing the area in question to be in the Shelton exchange and that Virgil Ramsey be grandfathered to receive service from the Kenesaw exchange.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a boundary be determined in docket No. C-811 which will eliminate the duplicate service area in question between the Kenesaw and Shelton exchanges.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that revised service area maps be filed by Lincoln Telephone Company and the Nebraska Central Telephone Company showing the area in question to be in the Shelton exchange with a note on the maps indicating that service to Virgil Ramsey is grandfathered from the Kenesaw exchange of Lincoln Telephone Company.
