OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By docket opened August 7, 1990, the Commission on its own motion seeks to determine the boundary between the Albion exchange of GTE North, Inc. and the Petersburg exchange of the Petersburg Telephone Company.

Both GTE North, Inc. and the Petersburg Telephone Company were notified of this docket and directed to propose a revised boundary which will eliminate the duplicate service area.

Both telephone companies have agreed that the area in question should be included in the Albion exchange of GTE North, Inc. and four customers, Arthur Medeiros, Rosemary Seier, Ray Thiern and Ray's Auto Clinic, should be allowed to continue to receive telephone service from the Petersburg exchange. Part of the area should be included in the Petersburg exchange and two customers, S. J. Bygland and the Immanuel Zion Lutheran Church, should be allowed to continue to receive Albion service. If the customer moves or sells the property or business or the existing service is disconnected for any other reason then new service must be provided solely by the company serving the area, the only exception being that service may be transferred to another family member who is a member of the household at that time.

The subscribers were notified of this proposal by certified mail on March 12, 1991, and given 30 days in which to request a public hearing. No response has been received.

Upon consideration of the docket and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that a boundary has been agreed upon by all parties which will eliminate the duplicate service area in question between the Albion and Petersburg exchanges. Both telephone companies should be ordered to file revised service area maps showing the area in question: that Arthur Medeiros, Rosemary Seier, Ray Thiern and Ray's Auto Clinic be grandfathered to receive service from the Petersburg exchange and that S. J. Bygland and Immanuel Zion Lutheran Church be grandfathered to receive service from the Albion exchange.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a boundary be determined in docket No. C-813 which will eliminate the duplicate service area in question between the Albion and Petersburg exchanges.



J. Bygland and Immanuel Zion Lutheran Church is grandfathered from the Albion exchange.


