## OPINION AND FINDINGS

## BY THE COMMISSION:

By docket opened August 7, 1990, the Commission on its own motion seeks to determine the boundary between the Belden exchange of Eastern Nebraska Telephone Company and the Randolph exchange of US West.

The purpose of this docket is to eliminate a duplicate service area between the Belden and Randolph exchanges. Both telephone companies were notified of the docket and requested to suggest boundary revisions.

US West Communications has responded by letter dated October 10, 1990, that the area is no longer a duplicate service area. There is no longer anyone in the area served by the Randolph exchange.

Upon consideration of the matter and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the docket should be dismissed and Eastern Nebraska Telephone Company and US West should be required to file appropriate service area maps reflecting that the area of concern in this docket should be included within the service area of the Belden exchange of Eastern Nebraska Telephone Company.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-816 be and it is hereby dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Eastern Nebraska Telephone Company and US West shall file with the Commission appropriate service area maps reflecting that the area of concern in this docket should be included within the service area of the Belden exchange of Eastern Nebraska Telephone Company.
