OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 7, 1990, the Commission on its own motion created this docket to determine the boundary between the Gurley exchange and the Lodgepole exchange both served by the Dalton Telephone Company. The Commission created this docket to investigate the possibility of establishing a boundary between these exchanges that would eliminate the current duplicated service area.

On August 10, 1990, a letter was sent to L. L. Swanson, President of the Dalton Telephone Company requesting information regarding the current service provided within this duplicated service area. The company was requested to provide a proposed boundary which would eliminate the duplicated service area between the Gurley and Lodgepole exchanges.

On September 24, 1990, the Commission received a response from Mr. Swanson which proposed a new boundary between these exchanges. The response included a map with the new proposed boundary indicated thereon. The Commission staff has prepared a map which reflects the proposed change to the boundary which will be attached to and made a part of this order.

The staff contacted the company to determine if any current subscribers would be affected by the proposed boundary change and the company indicated no subscriber's service would be affected by the proposal.

Upon consideration of the matter and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the boundary change proposed is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the boundary between the Gurley and Lodgepole exchanges served by the Dalton Telephone Company be revised as set forth in the map referred to in the Opinion and Findings, which by reference is made a part hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Dalton Telephone Company file revised service area maps with the Commission.
