OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By docket opened August 7, 1990, the Commission on its own motion seeks to determine the boundary between the Cozad exchange of the Cozad Telephone Company and the Gothenburg exchange of US West.

Both the Cozad Telephone Company and US West were notified of this docket and directed to propose a revised boundary which will eliminate the duplicate service area.

Five customers were notified of this proposal by certified mail on April 24, 1991.

The Commission received letters from Roland Lauer, Arnold M. Block and Reakus Franzen in opposition to the original proposal which would place them in the Cozad exchange with service from Gothenburg grandfathered.

Both telephone companies have agreed to a revised boundary proposal which will place the residences of Roland Lauer, Arnold M. Block and Reakus Franzen in the Gothenburg exchange served by US West. The service provided to Reakus Franzen from the Cozad exchange will be grandfathered. Lisa Brown and Archie Block should be allowed to continue to receive telephone service from the Gothenburg exchange on a grandfathered basis.

Upon consideration of the docket and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that a boundary has been agreed upon by all parties which will eliminate the duplicate service area in question between the Cozad and Gothenburg exchanges. Both telephone companies should be ordered to file revised service area maps showing the area in question; that Lisa Brown and Archie Block be grandfathered to receive service from the Gothenburg exchange and Reakus Franzen be grandfathered to receive service from the Cozad exchange.

ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a boundary be determined in docket No. C-826 which will eliminate the duplicate service area in question between the Cozad and Gothenburg exchanges.




