OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By docket opened August 7, 1990, the Commission on its own motion seeks to determine the boundary between the Fort Calhoun exchange of the Blair Telephone Company and the Omaha exchange of US West.

The purpose of this docket is to eliminate a duplicate service area between the Fort Calhoun and Omaha exchanges. Both telephone companies were notified of the docket and requested to suggest boundary revisions.

Both telephone companies have suggested a boundary that will eliminate the duplicate service area and will not affect current service provided to any customer.

Upon consideration of the matter and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that a boundary be determined which will eliminate the duplicate service area and the Blair Telephone Company and US West should be required to file appropriate service area maps.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a boundary be and it is hereby determined in Application No. C-852.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Blair Telephone Company and US West shall file with the Commission appropriate service area maps.
