By its application filed October 7, 1991, CLM Associates seeks a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide COMMUNITY LINK service in the local exchanges of US West Communications, Inc. in the state of Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application has been filed. The application was processed by modified procedure pursuant to Title 291, Chapter 1, Rule 018.03.

OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

Upon consideration of the application and being fully informed in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is a partnership formed by US West Communications, Inc. and Minitel Northwest, Inc. US West Communications, Inc. is a certificated provider of telecommunications services in Nebraska intrastate commerce and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission. Minitel Northwest, Inc. is a Delaware corporation with an office located at Minitel Holdings, Inc., 888 Seventh Avenue, New York, New York 10106. Applicant maintains a place of business in Omaha, Nebraska.

2. Applicant proposes to provide the same COMMUNITY LINK service that US West Communications, Inc. has been providing to Nebraska subscribers. US West Communications, Inc. is agreeable to the application and has filed its consent thereto. No duplication of facilities will be created.

3. Upon consideration of the application, affidavit and accompanying financial statements, and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and is of benefit to subscribers and other parties requiring telecommunications service.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-905 be and it is hereby granted, and that CLM Associates be and it is hereby authorized to provide COMMUNITY LINK service in the local exchanges of US West Communications, Inc. in the state of Nebraska.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant file a tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that US West Communications, Inc. revise its Services Catalog to reflect discontinuing the offering of Videotex Service.





