BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed February 6, 1992, AT&T, Omaha, Nebraska seeks authority to revise depreciation rates used to compute depreciation expense on its Nebraska intrastate investment.

Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record on February 7, 1992 in accordance with the Commission's rules. No protests to the application were received. The application will therefore be processed by modified procedure in accordance with the Commission's rules of procedure.

On April 14, 1987, this Commission entered an order in docket C-664 which adopted certain depreciation procedures establishing a triennial review of AT&T's depreciation rates which took place as scheduled in 1991. Subsequent to the order adopted on January 28, 1992 by the FCC based on the 1991 study, the applicant filed this application requesting similar treatment for its Nebraska intrastate investment.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Upon consideration of the application, the procedure adopted in Application No. C-664 and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

The remaining life depreciation rates found in Column F of Appendix A, attached to and made a part of this order, shall be the depreciation rates approved by this Commission effective on and after January 1, 1991.


ORDER


