OPINION AND FINDINGS

This docket was created to approve or disapprove plans submitted by certain affected telecommunications companies. Specifically, this docket sought whether to approve disposition of excess revenues resulting from decreases in personal property taxes for the 1991 tax year. See Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 86-803(9) (1992 Cum. Supp.).

In the case of the respondent which is the subject of this order, American Public Communications, Inc. (APC) is in Chapter 7 bankruptcy. API has had no presence in Nebraska and has not filed annual reports with this Commission. The Commission staff's research shows there is no personal property tax windfall affecting this company. The Respondent should therefore be dismissed from this docket with this order.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that American Public Communications, Inc. be and it is hereby dismissed from dockets C-931 and C-992.
