

On June 1, 1993, the Commission received a letter from Infodial's counsel asking that the Commission recognize the merger of Infodial and MarketLink, Inc. ("MarketLink"), a corporate entity

domiciled in Bloomington, Minnesota, and the substitution of MarketLink for Infodial as the party in interest.

Because the June 2, 1993 order was already on the agenda, we issued the order with the caption in its original form to expedite a final determination of the application. We therefore issue this order nunc pro tunc to recognize MarketLink as the party in interest to whom our original June 2nd order applies.

Upon consideration of the application, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds MarketLink, Inc. should be recognized as the applicant in Docket No. C-952 pursuant to this order nunc pro tunc.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that MarketLink, Inc., Bloomington, Minnesota, be and it is hereby formally recognized as the applicant in this matter and is substituted for the original applicant, Infodial, Inc. based on the merger of the two corporations into MarketLink, Inc.¹
