OPINION AND FINDINGS

On May 4, 1993, pursuant to Application No. C-970, Feist Long Distance Services (Feist) of Wichita, Kansas, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. On December 9, 1997, pursuant to Application No. C-1676, this Commission approved the transfer of control of Feist to Advanced Communications Group, Inc. On October 19, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-2095, this Commission approved the transfer of control of Feist from Advanced Communications Group, Inc. to Ionex Telecommunications, Inc. On April 5, 2000, pursuant to Application No. C-2224, Feist changed its name to Ionex Communications, Inc. (Ionex).

On April 10, 2000, the Commission received a letter from Ionex informing the Commission that Ionex seeks to relinquish its certificate of authority in Nebraska. Ionex is not currently providing service in Nebraska; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the cancellation of Ionex's certificate. The Commission is of the opinion that Ionex's request should be honored and its certificate should be canceled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-970 to Ionex Communications, Inc., formerly known as Feist Long Distance Services, Inc. be, and it is hereby, canceled.
