OPINION AND FINDINGS

On June 16, 1993, pursuant to Application No. C-973, West Coast Telecommunications, Inc. of Santa Barbara, California, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. Through subsequent applications granted by this Commission (see Application Nos. C-1069, C-1132, C-1556, and C-1779), West Coast Telecommunications now conducts business in Nebraska under the name Frontier Communications of the West, Inc.

Frontier, in a letter dated October 6, 2000, requests that their certificate be canceled. Frontier does not currently provide service in Nebraska and has no customers within the state, therefore, no Nebraska consumers will be impacted by the cancellation of Frontier's certificate. The Commission is of the opinion that Frontier's request should be honored and its certificate should be canceled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-973 to West Coast Telecommunications, Inc., now known as Frontier Communications of the West, Inc., be, and it is hereby, canceled.
