OPINION AND FINDINGS

LinkUSA Corporation (LinkUSA) filed its petition for authority to operate as a reseller and alternate operator services (AOS) provider February 18, 1993. Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record February 23, 1993. On May 17, 1993, the applicant moved to withdraw its application on the grounds that the services it provides are not within the jurisdiction of the Commission as a reseller or an AOS provider. Instead, LinkUSA serves resellers and AOS providers by providing third party data processing, billing, and other call completion services, including automated and live operators to interexchange carriers, resellers, and AOS providers (not to the public) to support their service offerings to end users.

Upon review and being fully informed, the Commission finds the motion to dismiss without prejudice should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the motion to dismiss Application No. C-976 be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice.
