O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Suntel North America, Inc. (Suntel) of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania filed its petition for authority to operate as described in the caption above on April 6, 1993. Notice of the application was duly published in the Omaha Daily Record the following day. On June 8, 1993, in response to a letter of inquiry from the Commission's Communications Department, Suntel asked to place the application in abeyance for six months (a period ending approximately December 8, 1993).

This application has not advanced any further since that time and, according to the Commission's legal counsel, a conversation with Suntel's management indicates the company is not ready nor will be ready in the foreseeable future to proceed. The Communications Department therefore seeks the dismissal of the application without prejudice to Suntel.

Upon review and being fully informed in the premises, the Commission finds the application should be dismissed without prejudice to Suntel.
