BY THE COMMISSION

1. On its own motion, the Commission made this application to amend the certificate of authority previously granted to Cable & Wireless Communications, Inc. (C&W) of Vienna, Virginia in Application No. C-867 (March 5, 1991). In that application, C&W requested authority to provide intrastate interLATA and intraLATA interexchange resale telecommunications services in Nebraska, but the Commission's final order granted only the interLATA portion requested, although that was not the intent. C&W has operated since then with the understanding that it actually had both intraLATA and interLATA authority.

Being fully advised, the Commission finds that this application should be dismissed and the matter disposed of pursuant to an order nunc pro tunc under the original application.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1023 be and it is hereby dismissed.
