PRELIMINARY MATTERS

By application filed February 14, 1994, LiTel Telecommuni-
cations Corporation dba LCI International ("LCI") of Dub-
lin, Ohio seeks authority to amend its certificate of public
convenience and necessity to reflect a name change to "LCI
International Telecom Corp." For convenience we shall refer
to the applicant throughout as "LCI." LCI's principal of-
fice is noted above and its books and records are maintained at
the same address. The applicant's registered agent is the CT
Corporation, 206 South 13th Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, 68508.

Notice of the application was published in the Omaha
DAILY RECORD February 16, 1994 in accordance with the
Commission's rules of procedure. No protests to the applica-
tion were received. We therefore process this application
pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure (Title
291 NAC Ch. 1, Rule 018.03).

BY THE COMMISSION

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules¹, contents of the application, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

LCI previously obtained authority to operate as an intra-state reseller in Application No. C-909 (February 18, 1992). The applicant received additional operator service authority in Application No. C-1015 (January 14, 1994). The current application demonstrates that the general information about the company remains virtually the same since the time of the two prior applications.

The name change was made only for the purpose of administrative convenience and does not affect LCI's corporate status or its status as a public utility, nor will the change result in any change in the management, operations, quality of service or rates of the company. The name change will have no effect on the ability of the company to provide reasonable and adequate service throughout Nebraska. Upon a grant of this application, LCI's tariff should be modified and re-filed with the Commission to reflect the name change.

Based on the contents of the application and the exhibits, the application is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1052 be, and it is hereby, granted and the current certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to LiTel Telecommunications Corporation dba LCI International, Inc. of Dublin, Ohio to provide intrastate long distance reseller services and alternate operator service in Nebraska be, and it is hereby, amended to reflect a change in name to LCI International Telecom Corp.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall continue to file, in accordance with the applicable statutes, an annual report with this Commission consisting of (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) the annual report to stockholders, and (c) for the state of Nebraska on a combined interstate-intrastate basis, the investment, if any, in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues, operating expenses, and taxes. This shall be done under the company's new name as reflected by this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated and corrected tariff reflecting the company's new name.
