On March 10, 1994, Cable USA, Inc., of Scottsbluff, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, filed an application docketed as Application C-1060. Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record on March 17, and April 21, 1994.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On January 17, 1995, the applicant filed a motion with the Commission to dismiss the above-mentioned application. The applicant indicates that it will file a new application for the authority to provide intrastate interexchange resale service. At this time, the applicant does not desire to provide local exchange service. Therefore, it requests its application for such authority be dismissed.

After consideration of the motion and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. The motion should be granted.
2. Application C-1060 should be dismissed and the hearing scheduled for January 31, 1995 cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the applicant's motion to dismiss be, and it is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ordered that Application C-1060 be, and it is hereby dismissed and the hearing scheduled for January 31, 1995 is cancelled.




