OPINION AND FINDINGS

Communications Gateway Network, Inc., obtained a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in October, 1992 in Application No. C-940. Since certification, no formal complaints or departmental complaints have been filed against the company.

If this application is granted, CGN will transfer stock to WinStar Communications, Inc. The transfer of ownership will not affect the company's management, operations, quality of service or rates. Granting this application will have no effect on the ability of the company to provide reasonable and adequate service throughout Nebraska.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1101 be, and it is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall continue to file, in accordance with the applicable statutes, an annual report with this Commission consisting of (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) the annual report to stockholders, and (c) for the state of Nebraska on a combined interstate - intrastate basis, the investment, if any, in telephone plant and equipment located
