## PRELIMINARY MATTERS

By application filed December 23, 1994, RCI Long Distance, Inc., of Rochester, New York seeks approval to change its name to Frontier Communications International, Inc. The applicant's principal office will remain located at 180 South Clinton Ave., Rochester, New York, 14646.

Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record, December 27, 1994 in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Procedure. No protests to the application were received. Therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure (see Title 291, NAC Ch. 1, Rule 018.03).

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

RCI Long Distance, Inc. was granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to C-1066 on July 19, 1994. Since certification, no formal complaints have been filed against the company in Nebraska.

The company's current accounting practices, its Articles of Incorporation, by-laws and other significant aspects of internal corporate organization will remain the same. Further, the name change will not affect the company's operations, quality of service or rates. The new President of the company is Daniel Latham and Dale Gregory is now Chief Executive Officer. The name change is being made as Rochester Tel, RCI's former parent company, is currently operating as Frontier Corporation. Frontier Communications International, Inc. will be a wholly owned subsidiary of Frontier Corporation.

Based on the contents of the application and the exhibits, the application is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.
