OPINION AND FINDINGS

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

Equal Net Communications, Inc. was granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to C-986 on September 28, 1993. Since certification, no formal complaints have been filed against the company in Nebraska.

The proposed name change will not alter the current accounting practices, the Articles of Incorporation, the by-laws or any other significant aspect of its internal corporate organization. Further, the name change will not affect the company's management, operations, quality of service or rates. The name change is being made solely to improve marketing efforts.

Based on the contents of the application and the exhibits, the application is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.
