BY THE COMMISSION

By application filed January 20, 1995, Steve and Raelynn Bygland seek authority to receive telephone service from the Albion exchange served by GTE Midwest, Inc. (GTE) in lieu of current service provided by Petersburg Telephone Company (Petersburg). Petersburg filed a protest to the application on February 22, 1995. Also on February 22, 1995, Petersburg served interrogatories on the applicants, requesting answers be returned within thirty (30) days.

On March 21, 1995, the applicants requested an extension of time in order to fully answer the interrogatories filed by Petersburg. The Commission approved the request on March 28, 1995 and gave the applicants until April 17, 1995 to respond.

On April 14, 1995, the applicants filed a motion with the Commission to withdraw the application. After consideration of the motion and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the motion should be granted and Application No. C-1149 should be dismissed without prejudice.


O R D E R
