BY THE COMMISSION:

By letter filed September 22, 1997, Valu-Line of Kansas, Inc. (Valu-Line) of Emporia, Kansas, requests that its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be withdrawn.

Valu-Line received a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services within Nebraska on September 26, 1995, in Application C-1180.

Valu-Line states it has no network operations in Nebraska, nor is it marketing its products and services in the state. Further, Valu-Line states it has no plans to provide service in Nebraska; and, therefore, a certificate is no longer needed.

Valu-Line has no outstanding informal or formal complaints and all applicable annual reports have been remitted to the Commission.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the request is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.


