

M. Gene Hand, Director of the Nebraska Public Service Commission's Communications Department, petitions the Nebraska Public Service Commission in the matter against LDM Systems, Inc. and its officers and alleges as follows:

1. Complainant is Director of the Department of Communications of this Commission.
2. Defendant operates as a reseller of intrastate interLATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska without a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity contrary to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-604 (Cum. Supp. 1994).
3. Defendant is aware that a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is needed. By certified letter dated April 6, 1995, complainant informed defendant that its operations were illegal and requested it become certified. The defendant has failed to respond and continues to provide telecommunications services in this state.

WHEREFORE, complainant prays that the Commission convene a hearing on the foregoing petition pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-131 (Cum. Supp. 1994) and enter an order requiring defendant to cease and desist from offering telephone communications services in Nebraska pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-133 (Cum Supp. 1994).
