PRELIMINARY MATTERS

By application filed April 20, 1995, Cherry Communications, Inc. of Westchester, Illinois seeks authority to provide interLATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services within Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record on April 24, 1995. A public hearing was held on the docket on June 13, 1995 in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On July 31, 1995, the Commission entered an order granting Cherry Communications, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as Cherry) the authority to operate on a conditional basis to August 31, 1995. The order was contingent upon Cherry providing the Commission with requisite financial information.

As of this date, Cherry has provided financial information to the Commission; however, some information continues to be outstanding and some additional questions have been raised. Therefore, the Communications Department of the Commission comes forward to request an extension of time for Cherry to provide the requested information and for the staff to fully review the submitted documents.

The Commission being fully advised in the premises finds the request for an extension of time is reasonable, in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Cherry Communications, Inc. is hereby allowed to operate on a conditional basis until September 26, 1995.


