OPINION AND FINDINGS

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules¹, the contents of the application, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

Enterprise Telcom Services, Inc. (ETS) was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity pursuant to Application No. C-929 on September 1, 1992. ETS was granted authority to provide intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA services within Nebraska.

The current application states ETS discontinued selling telecommunications services in Nebraska on August 1, 1994. Therefore, a certificate is no longer needed.

The company has no outstanding informal or formal complaints and all applicable annual reports have been remitted to the Commission.

Based on the contents of the application, the request is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.
