OPINION AND FINDINGS

The petition in the caption above is filed by the Communications Department (the "Department") of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (the "Commission") by and through its Director, M. Gene Hand, on July 6, 1995. The Department petitioned the Commission to revoke the intrastate operating authority of the following telecommunications companies (the "Defendants") and that they be ordered to cease and desist from operating in Nebraska:

American Telecommunications Enterprise, Inc.; C-1051
American Telephone Network, Inc.; C-935
Calls for Less, Inc.; C-1115
Communications Gateway; C-940
ComTel Computers; C-806
Excel Telecommunications; C-885

The defendants are telecommunications companies generally regulated by the Commission pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stats. 75-101 et seq. (1994 Cum. Supp.) and 86-801 to 86-11 (Reissue 1994). These companies are also governed by Title 291, NAC Ch. 5 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

As part of its regulatory authority and pursuant to 86-807, the Commission, through its Communications Department, requires telecommunications companies which file an annual report with a federal agency to file a copy of same report with the Commission on or before the date on which said report is filed with the federal agency. Every such company not required to file such a report with a federal agency shall file an annual report with the Commission in a form prescribed on or before April 30 of each year.

In the case of the defendants, proper and complete annual reports have not been filed for 1994, as of the date of this petition. Each company was notified by the staff two times by first class mail, January 10 and May 5, 1995, that the annual report was due. None of the defendants had filed a report by the date of the petition.

Since the petition was filed, American Telecommunications Enterprise, Inc. and PetraCom Corporation have complied with the reporting requirements previously described. Therefore, American Telecommunications Enterprise and PetraCom should be dismissed from this docket since the subject of the petition has been satisfied. We take this opportunity to warn the companies that the Commission will not continually accept such late filed reports. If similar disregard is given the annual report due in 1996, such a dismissal may not be permitted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the departmental complaint filed against American Telecommunications Enterprise, Inc. and PetraCom Corporation in Docket C-1207 / Departmental Complaint 015, be and it is hereby, dismissed as satisfied.
