PRELIMINARY MATTERS

The Southeast Nebraska Telephone Company of Falls City, Nebraska filed an application to revise the boundary between its Falls City exchange and the Dawson exchange, served by the Lincoln Telephone Company, on July 19, 1995. Specifically, the applicant requests a boundary change be made so as to allow Mr. Ivan Newsam, a current customer of Lincoln Telephone Company to receive service from Southeast Nebraska Telephone Company. Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record on July 21, 1995 pursuant to the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

BY THE COMMISSION

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

The Southeast Nebraska Telephone Company and The Lincoln Telephone Company are local exchange carriers operating in Nebraska and are subject to the Commission's general regulation of common carriers. This application is governed specifically by Neb. Rev. Stats. 75-604 to 75-616 (1994 Reissue). These statutes establish that if the telephone company or companies affected by the proposed boundary exchange do not object to the application, the application may be processed by modified procedure. In this case, no protests were received; therefore, the Commission will proceed pursuant to its Rule of Modified Procedure.

Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a boundary map marking the proposed revision that would move the Newsam property from the Lincoln Telephone Company territory into the Southeast Nebraska Telephone Company area. Lincoln Telephone has agreed to the boundary change and a statement of acceptance from Lincoln Telephone is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the request reasonable, in the public interest and should be granted.
