PRELIMINARY MATTERS

By application filed October 26, 1995, Bottom Line Telecommunications, Inc. of Vancouver, Washington seeks approval to change its name to BLT Technologies, Inc. Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record, October 30, 1995 in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Procedure. No protests to the application were received. Therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure (see Title 291, NAC Ch. 1, Rule 018.03).

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

Bottom Line Telecommunications was granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to C-1094 on October 4, 1994. Since certification, no formal complaints have been filed against the company in Nebraska.

The proposed name change will not noticeably impact customers in Nebraska and will not affect the company's management, operations, quality of service or rates. The change is being made to reflect a name that is more closely associated with its growing base of technology related businesses and the company believes it will enhance its sales opportunities.

Based on the contents of the application, the request is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1255 be, and it is hereby granted and the current name of Bottom Line Telecommunications, Inc. is changed to BLT Technologies, Inc.
