O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On February 20, 1996, pursuant to Application No. C-1260, Pantel Communications, Inc. of DeKalb, Illinois, was granted authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA resold interexchange telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

On March 9, 2000, the Commission received a letter from Pantel Communications, Inc. requesting that its certificate of operating authority be canceled. Pantel has discontinued its operations, is insolvent and out of business. Pantel's Nebraska intrastate revenue for 1999 amounted to \$269.16. The Commission finds that the applicant's certificate and tariff should be canceled.

O R D E R


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the authority originally granted to applicant in Application No. C-1260, and applicant's tariff be, and it is hereby, canceled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pantel Communications, Inc. notify in writing, any remaining Nebraska customers regarding the cancellation of its certificate and discontinuation of service.


