#### PRELIMINARY MATTERS

On November 14, 1995, The Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company, of Jackson, Nebraska filed an application to revise the boundary between its Clearwater exchange and the Neligh exchange which is served by General Telephone Company. Notice of the application was published in the <u>Omaha Daily Record</u> on November 15, 1995 pursuant to the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

## BY THE COMMISSION

#### OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company (Northeast) and General Telephone Company (GTE) are local exchange carriers operating in Nebraska and are subject to the Commission's general regulation of common carriers. This application is governed specifically by Neb. Rev. Stats. 75-604 to 75-616 (1994 Reissue). These statutes establish that if the telephone company or companies affected by the proposed boundary exchange do not object to the application, the application may be processed by modified procedure. In this case, no protests were received; therefore, the Commission will proceed pursuant to its Rule of Modified Procedure.

In the present application, Jerry and Dennis McKillip, subscribers of General Telephone Company desire to receive service from The Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company. Mr. and Mrs. McKillip state their business and personal relationships are located in Clearwater and would prefer to receive service from that community.

Attached hereto as Exhibit B is a boundary map marking the proposed revision that would move the McKillip property from GTE territory into Northeast's area. GTE has agreed to the boundary change and a statement of acceptance from the company is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the

request reasonable, in the public interest and should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1264 be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that The Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company and The General Telephone Company remit a revised boundary map to the Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.
