Therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure (see Title 291, NAC Ch. 1, Rule 018.03).

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

Cable & Wireless Communications, Inc. was granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to C-867 on March 5, 1991. Since certification, no formal complaints have been filed against the company in Nebraska.

The proposed name change will not noticeably impact customers in Nebraska and will not affect the company's management, ownership, quality of service or rates. Furthermore, the change is relatively minor.

Based on the contents of the application, the request is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1287 be, and it is hereby granted and the current name of Cable & Wireless Communications, Inc. is changed to Cable and Wireless, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff with the Commission within thirty (30) days reflecting the authorized change in name.
