## PRELIMINARY MATTERS

By application filed March 11, 1996, American Telephone Network, Inc. of Wellington, Florida seeks authority to withdraw their Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was filed in the Omaha Daily Record on March 12, 1996. No protests to the application were received; therefore, we will process this docket pursuant to the Commission Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On June 22, 1992, the applicant, American Telephone Network, Inc. (ATN) filed an application, C-935, with the Commission for authority to transact business as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record on June 24, 1992. A hearing was held on the application on August 24, 1992 and authority was granted for the applicant to provide interexchange interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services on October 20, 1992.

By letter dated February 19, 1996, ATN requested permission to withdraw its certificate of authority in Nebraska. The letter provides that ATN has discontinued operations in Nebraska and had no sales, assets or employees in Nebraska during 1995. No formal, informal or departmental complaints are pending against the company.

ATN seeks to withdraw its certificate, as it does not currently and will not in the future, transact business within Nebraska. Therefore, the company does not need to have an active certificate or tariff on file.

After consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the request reasonable and that American Telephone Network, Inc. of Wellington, Florida may withdraw its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Application No. C-935.
