OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed June 7, 1996, RRV Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Consumer Access, of Houston, Texas, seeks authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA resold telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 10, 1996, pursuant to the rules of the Commission. No protests were filed. Hearing on the application was held by video communication on August 28, 1996.

Applicant produced one witness, Bruce Robin, who testified: He is secretary of applicant corporation. He has examined the application and finds that it is current and correct. Applicant will solicit business through sales agents in the local area. Applicant offers a toll free customer response line. No facilities will be based in Nebraska. Applicant targets travellers. Its main offering is a customer calling card. Most of its customers are small business and residential subscribers. Billing will be done by the customer's local exchange carrier.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. 75-604 and 86-805 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein and the testimony adduced at the hearing, the Commission finds applicant

has provided all the information required by the Commission; possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE Nebraska Public Service that Application Number C-1361 be, and it is hereby, granted and RRV Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Consumer Access, Houston, Texas, hereby authorized to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders, (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission, (d) a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation and (e) for the State of Nebraska on a combined interstate-intrastate basis, the investment in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues, operating expenses, and taxes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that quarterly financial statements be furnished for the second, third and fourth quarters of 1996.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
