PRELIMINARY MATTERS

By application filed May 13, 1996, Matrix Telecom, a Texas General Partnership, of Fort Worth, Texas, seeks approval to change its name to Matrix Telecom, Inc. Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record, June 21, 1996 in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Procedure. No protests to the application were received. Therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure (see Title 291, NAC Ch. 1, Rule 018.03).

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

Matrix Telecom was granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to C-865 on February 19, 1991. The authority was granted to Matrix Telecom which at the time was a Texas' general partnership. However, for tax purposes, Matrix Telecom changed its status as a partnership to a corporation.

The application states the name change will in no way involve a change in the operation, control, or ultimate ownership of the Company. No change in the rates, terms, or conditions of Matrix Telecom's service to Nebraska customers will take place.

The name change will not alter the company's day-to-day operations, services or management; therefore, customers should not experience any visible changes by approving this application.

Based on the contents of the application, the request is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.
