O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On October 8, 1996, pursuant to Application No. C-1378, Cincinnati Bell Long Distance, Inc. (CBLD) of Cincinnati, Ohio, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska.

CBLD, in a letter dated August 30, 2000, requests that their certificate be canceled. CBLD does not currently provide service in Nebraska and has no customers within the state, therefore, no Nebraska consumers will be impacted by the cancellation of CBLD's certificate. The Commission is of the opinion that CBLD's request should be honored and its certificate should be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-1378 to Cincinnati Bell Long Distance, Inc., be, and it is hereby, canceled.
