O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

BY THE COMMISSION

On August 6, 1996, Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company (now named Aliant) of Lincoln, Nebraska filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to adjust its rates and charges for telephone service to its Yutan Exchange in accordance with the Commission's order entered in Application No. C-1277 on August 1, 1996.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provision of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Notice of the application appeared in the Omaha Daily Record on August 8, 1996. No protests or petitions for formal intervention to the application were filed. Therefore, this application will be processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure (see Rule 018.03).

LT&T seeks the following revisions in the basic local service rates for its Yutan exchange:

Business (B-1)	39.00/Month
Lamp & Key	45.00/Month
PBX	55.00/Month
Coin Semi-Public Service	23.50/Month
Individual Incoming Only	33.25/Month
Lamp & Key Incoming Only	38.25/Month

O R D E R


