By application filed August 19, 1996, GlobalOne, Inc. of Chicago, Illinois, seeks approval to change its name to MetroLink Communications, Inc. ("MetroLink"). Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record, August 21, 1996 in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Procedure. No protests to the application were received. Therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure (see Title 291, NAC Ch. 1, Rule 018.03).

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

GlobalOne, Inc. is a corporation existing under the laws of the State of Illinois with its principal office located at 70 West Madison, Suite 5000; Chicago, Illinois.

GlobalOne was issued and continues to operate pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity that was granted by the Commission in Application C-1299 on June 12, 1995.

The application states the name change will in no way involve a change in the operation, control, or ultimate ownership of the Company. No change in the rates, terms, or conditions of GlobalOne's service to Nebraska customers will take place.

Based on the contents of the application, the request is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1401 be, and it is hereby granted and the current name of GlobalOne, Inc., is changed to MetroLink Communications, Inc.




